2019 Classes

Early next term we will be looking at placing children into classes for 2019. It is extremely important for our planning that we have accurate student numbers. Please notify us as soon as possible if you intend to enrol your child at North Ingle School or Preschool or if you are leaving the school in 2019. In determining the structure of classes some of the factors we consider include:

- * friendship groups
- * gender balance
- * academic ability
- * social and emotional well-being
- * students with special needs



Decisions are made based on establishing balanced and equitable class groups.

Arranging classes is an enormous task and takes a huge amount of time and consideration.

Parents and Caregivers have the opportunity to put in writing any special circumstances around their child or children's learning they would like us to consider when doing class placements.

Parents are not able to request specific teachers and please note that teachers have not been allocated to year levels or classes at this stage. Traditionally all students and families are notified of classes on the first day of the school year when we assemble in the undercover area.

Where possible we do try to accommodate special circumstances, however we cannot guarantee that all requests can or will be met. Letters of requests need to be returned to the school by no later than the end of Week 2 Term 4 and addressed as **Confidential** to the **Principal - Dina Zunis**.

At the audition there were three or four hundred people trying to get the part and only 10 people were picked—I was one of those lucky ones!!

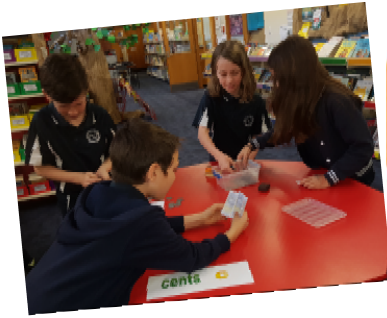
During the audition we were divided into groups of nine. We had to act, dance and sing the song "We're off to see the Wizard".

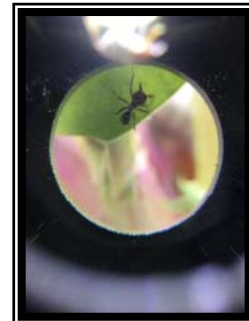

SCIENCE WEEK IN THE PRESCHOOL



After taking part in Science Week in Week 4 the Preschool children have taken an interest in being scientists and this has been our focus over the term.



We began by making crystals and volcanoes and have also moved onto floating and sinking. We have also taken part in a balloon rocket experiment.

A microscope has also been introduced at Preschool which allows the children to take a photo and look at the image up close.

We will also be moving onto a celery colour experiment and looking at plants growing in both light and dark places.

Making Crystals

For science week the preschool children become scientists and made their very own crystals. The children worked with Kanon to place the ingredients into their cup. As the children prepared their crystals they made predictions about what might happen. After 2 weeks the children set as a group and put their science hats on again and commented on what had happened to their crystals, most of the children said 'mines grown bigger' or 'there is a crystal on my string' the children then made a prediction about what might happen in a week's time with most saying 'the crystals will grow bigger'. Through this experience the children were able to use reflective thinking to consider why things happen and what can be learnt from these experiences.

SCIENCE WEEK MAKING VOLCANOS

As well as making crystals this week for science week we also experimented making our own volcanoes in the sand!

The children worked together covering small plastic bottles in sand then took turns adding 'magma', (dyeing water) and some food coloring (we added red to make it look like lava) then happily we added the bicarb soda to start the eruption!

The children loved doing this fun experiment. We talked before and after about what the children predicted would happen. It encouraged the children to observe, experiment, reflect and communicate. Great work little scientists!
