Ms Ktoris has briefly outlined and planned the Term 4 overview for the class:

In Term 4, students will learn new vocabulary related to food items and engage in Auslan to share information about themselves and their immediate surroundings, using play-based and action-oriented learning activities.

By the end of term 4, the students will be able to:

- Understand how to create complete sentences through movement within signs.
- Work with information to create a class video, identifying and categorising a select range of signs according to handshape.

- Create captions in English for short recorded signed phrases.
- Play matching-pair games with Auslan sign image flashcards and English.
- Compare two signed versions of a popular story and indicate their preference for one version of the other.
- View short Auslan stories by a teacher and identify specific points of information and record the observations.

Week 1-5 Tennis skills
